

TERMS OF REFERENCE

D2N2 Provider Advisory Board

The Board is a strategic group made up of members from the top 10 Core Providers of D2N2 Priority Sectors, top 10 ESF providers over the last 5 years, HEI's (University of Derby, Nottingham Trent University and University of Nottingham) and Provider Representative Groups.

The Board will be chaired by the Chief Executive of the EMFEC Group

The Board will feed directly into the Skills and Employment Commission.

Primary Role

To assist the D2N2 LEP in delivering the Skills for Growth Strategy.

To inform, drive and promote the development of a demand-led, value added and destination driven employment and skills provision across Derby, Derbyshire, Nottingham and Nottinghamshire.

Purpose

- 1 To provide a communications conduit to/from the LEP
- 2 To debate issues, share good practice and to inform LEP of on-going concerns, issues.
- 3 To gain confidence in the LEP and what it is doing around skills and employment
- 4 To encourage providers to buy-in to the 'localised' employment and skills agenda through a D2N2 Provider Charter.
- 5 To act as a conduit to inform providers about what the D2 and N2 ESBs are doing
- 6 To provide feedback from the consultative task groups
- 7 To discuss all inclusive D2N2 joint bids
- 8 To encourage more delivery in the D2N2 key sectors and area

Frequency of Meetings

Meetings to be held two – three weeks ahead of the Skills and Employment Commission meetings.
